

Residence Status Supplemental Form

This form must be completed in addition to the "Residence and Tuition Status Application" by **applicants who are not U.S.Citizens**. The directions, certifications, and acknowledgements for this supplemental form are the same as those on the main form and are incorporated herein by reference.

TYPE ALL RESPONSES OR PRINT THEM IN INK

Aliens are subject to the same considerations as United States citizens in the determination of residency status for tuition purposes unless:

- A. The alien abides in the United States under a visa conditioned at least in part upon intent not to abandon a foreign domicile (B, F, H, and J visas).
- B. The alien abides in the United States under a visa issued for a purpose so restricted as to be fundamentally incompatible with the assertion by the alien of bona fide residency intent (C and D visas).
- C. If an alien has a visa and physically surrenders it to immigration authorities, he or she is still deemed to be abiding in the United States under that visa until immigration authorities issue another document.

Employment Authorization is not itself a visa and is not itself evidence of capacity to remain in the United States indefinitely.
